Requirements to become a North Dakota Registered Pharmacy Technician

To be a North Dakota Registered Pharmacy Technician, the following requirements must be met:

- Successful completion of an academic experiential rotation program accredited by the American Society of Health Systems Pharmacists (ASHP)/accreditation council for pharmacy education (ACPE) or in a similarly accredited on-thejob self-instructional pharmacy technician study program under the supervision of a licensed pharmacist.
- Certification by a national certification body. Pharmacy Technician Certification Board (PTCB) and National Healthcareer Association (NHA) are approved certification bodies by the North Dakota Board of Pharmacy.
